Telecommunications Global Market 2016 Analysis and Forecast to 2021

telecommunications market in
Germany will generate service revenue
of \$48.9bn (€44.7bn) in 2016. Telecom
services revenue will grow at a CAGR of
0.5% in local currency over 2016-2021,
mainly due to Deutsche Telekom's (DT)
migration of circuit-switched lines to IP
technology. Mobile data will be the
largest contributor to overall service
revenue in 2016, accounting for 26% of
total revenue. During 2016-2021,
mobile data will witness CAGR of 5.7%



in local currency, owing to rising LTE adoption, growth in mobile data usage and M2M revenue. Fixed VoIP will record a strong CAGR of 13.9% over 2016-2021, while fixed broadband and pay-TV will register CAGRs of 3.1% and 4.8%, respectively, during the same period. Operators should seize opportunities in FMC, data and video services, and IoT/M2M. LTE expansion and investments in fiber deployments by operators will present opportunities for vendors and investors.

Key Findings

- The overall telecom service revenue in Germany is estimated to increase by 2.1% over 2016-2021 to reach \$48.9bn in 2016. The telecommunications market in Germany will see service revenue growth boosted by mobile data, fixed VoIP and fixed broadband segments.
- Mobile revenue will account for 48.0% of the total telecom market in 2016. Mobile data will be an important driver of this trend, as it will expand at a 7.3% CAGR from 2016 to 2021, driven by growth in the adoption of LTE services and M2M revenue.
- We expect the contribution of Internet access to fixed services revenue will increase from 52.0% in 2016 to 59.4% in 2021.
- The telecom market in Germany will be controlled by two operators Deutsche Telekom and Vodafone Germany. Operators are focusing on quad-play bundled packages and integrated (FMC) service offerings to strengthen their position in the telecom market.
