## Presidential Candidate De La Fuente to Debate Trump and Clinton

ORLANDO, Florida, October 18, 2016 – Presidential Candidate “Rocky” Roque De La Fuente will be participating in Wednesday night’s presidential debate along with Donald Trump and Hillary Clinton. He just won’t be in the same room.

De La Fuente will be participating via a ‘livestream’ version of the debate sponsored by iSideWith.com. He is the only candidate to have joined in the entire Town Hall that was held on October 9th. Darrell Castle, the Conservative Party’s nominee, and Dr. Jill Stein, the Green Party’s nominee, answered a handful of questions during the Town Hall, but De La Fuente weighed in on every single question.

iSideWith, the organization that will broadcast the ‘livestream’ version of the debate, also hosts an interactive, non-partisan website that aligns voters with candidates, issues and ballot measures and gives them the tools to share, compare and discuss their beliefs through social media. With over 40 million users in 12 countries and a reputation for extensive coverage of the latest political issues, iSideWith is the most popular political information platform in the world.

De La Fuente, an independent candidate who also has won the nominations of the Reform Party and the American Delta Party, mirrors elements of both Clinton and Trump. He ran against Clinton in almost every the Democratic primary and caucus, and he is an extremely successful businessman like Trump.

De La Fuente is quick to point out a few key differences. “I don’t have to pretend to understand minority issues, like Hillary, because I am a minority,” said De La Fuente. In fact, he is the only first-generation Hispanic American to have ever qualified to run for President in the General Election.

Then, he added with a smile, “I guess that also makes me the antidote to Trump; a successful Hispanic American businessman who helped bring about the border crossing in Otay Mesa, California.” According to his website, De La Fuente became the first citizen to exchange private land with the State of California when he traded 787 acres to be used in the construction of the Donovan Penitentiary in Otay Mesa in return for 310 acres next to where an international border crossing was being planned. He simply did not think that it was appropriate for someone’s first glimpse of the United States to be a prison complex. For his efforts, De la Fuente was honored to be the first person to cross the Otay Mesa Border Crossing when it opened in January 24th, 1985.

iSideWith will not only provide a livestream of the debate along with De La Fuente's answers as well as those of any other candidate with a pathway to 270 electors, it will also be tweeting many of the best quotes from the debate. Its username on Twitter is @iSideWith. De La Fuente's username is @VoteRocky2016, but he laughed and said, "I think I'm going to be a little too busy to tweet during the debate."
