


TealPower 1965 Thunderbird For Ovarian Cancer Awareness Raffled September 16th, 2017 At Summit Park In Cincinnati, Ohio

OCAGC is an all-volunteer, non-profit ovarian cancer group whose mission is to create public awareness for the symptoms of ovarian cancer, to provide support, resources, and education to ovarian cancer survivors

and caregivers, and to fund research focused on early detection and a cure. \$200,000 was donated to research in 2016 alone!

The Best Prevention is early detection...Pap Tests Do Not Detect Ovarian Cancer There is no screening method for early detection of ovarian cancer. The symptoms of the disease are vague, and are not always gynecologic. Research shows that women with ovarian cancer often report having one or more of the following symptoms so remember BEAT:

- B Bloating that is persistent and doesn't come and go
- E Eating less and feeling fuller.
- A Abdominal or pelvic pain.
- T Take action and see your doctor, preferably a gynecologist, if these symptoms are unusual for you and occur almost

daily for more than a few weeks.

Additional symptoms reported by women with ovarian cancer include fatigue, indigestion, back pain, pain with intercourse, constipation, and menstrual irregularities.
