In this report, the market share and size of these mentioned agriculture equipment have been tracked. Tractor sales for the year 2012 was 1.77 million units, which increased by 15% in 2013. However, the sales volume is predicted to increase and reach 2.286 million units by 2022. Sprayers' sale was 14,725 units in 2012, and is expected to reach 16,920 units by 2022.

The key market players are AGCO Corporation, Alamo Group, Claas Group, CNH Industrial NV, Deere & Company, Escorts Group, ISEKI & Company Limited, Kubota Corporation, Mahindra & Mahindra (M&M), and Same Deutz-FAHR Group S.P.A. These companies rely on product development, and mergers & acquisitions to expand their market and curb the inflow of new entrants into the market. The expected growth rate between 2016 and 2022 of the market would remain less than 5% because of restraining factors such as high cost of equipment, fluctuating weather conditions, altering government policies, and dynamic economic environment.
