Non-compliant organizations face potential fines of up to 4% of annual global revenue or €20 million (about \$21 million) – whichever is greater.



Alan Calder, the founder and executive chairman of IT Governance, said: "Currently, US organizations are required to register under and comply with the EU-US Privacy Shield in order to obtain permits for data transfers from the EU to the US. Next year, organizations will have to recertify once the Privacy Shield is updated to contain the GDPR requirements. That's why we urge organizations to take action now and start their GDPR compliance projects to avoid the tough fines the Regulation imposes."
