Just over four years ago, King moved from Washington, D.C. to Rhode Island. "I am still in the thrill of relocation, where every day produces a new discovery, a new reminder that I am not from the region, much as I appreciate it," he said.

King is executive producer and host of White House Chronicle, a weekly national news and public affairs program, airing on PBS and SiriusXM Radio. He is also a columnist for the InsideSources syndicate.

He worked for the BBC and The Washington Post as well as running a successful publishing company, whose titles included The Energy Daily, Defense Week and New Technology Week.

He is married to journalist and Middle East expert Linda Gasparello, a native of Hingham, Mass.
