Tip 1 – Remove all shoes when walking on your beautiful hard wood floors.

Sand has razor sharp edges that will cut and break down the finish of a wood floor. This also includes dirt or other foreign debris that take away a beautiful finish over time.

"We understand that it's not always easy to remember to remove the shoes, but if you do, this will go a

long way to keeping your floors looking shiny and beautiful for a long time before having to re-coat or polish them", Allman.

Tip 2 – Cutting down on harmful ultraviolet rays.

Close blinds and/or drapes when not home to save floor from fading in those areas. Over time, the ultra violet rays of the sun can cause the coating or protective sealant on the wood floors to oxidize. If left un-handled for extended periods of time, the wood itself can be affected. While buffing and re-coating can remedy this problem, it's just as easy to extend the life of the floors beauty by taking precautions.

Tip 3 – Keeping up with maintenance.

Keep up to date with buff and coats to preserve the ware layer of finish.

Routine buffing and coating of your hard wood floors can keep them protected and looking beautiful for many years. Do not use vinegar on your wood floors.

Never use vinegar to clean a floor with water based finish. Just use water or a top name brand cleaning kit. There are cleaning kits that are available on the market that can help you keep your floors routinely maintained without damaging



the wood itself. Many professionals in the field of caring for hard wood floors recommend Bona as the cleaner of choice. It is non-toxic and environmentally friendly.

Tip 5 – Keeping pet nails trimmed.

Keep your pets nails trimmed to prevent scratches.

Let's face it, we love our furry friends and they are an important part of our lives. However, in order to have those beautiful hard wood floors you must keep their nails trimmed in order to maintain a scratch-free floor that stays beautiful. And they will appreciate it too!

Tip 6 – Prevent a cloudy finish.

Prevent your floors from having a cloudy surface finish. Be careful with hairspray and furniture polish, both can cloud your finish. Over time this cloudy finish can wear on the surface coating of your floors as well as prevent the natural wood grain from beautifying your space. Also, avoid oil soaps as they can build up and create problems when it's time for a maintenance coat of finish.

Tip 7 – Protection from high traffic.

Use area rugs to keep wood floors protected. Protect high traffic areas of your hard wood floors with area rugs. To maintain protect high traffic areas with area rugs. It's best to use area rugs without vinyl or rubber backing to prevent anything from sticking to the floors that might damage the floors protective coating.

Tip 8 – Keep out the rain.

Keep your beautiful hard wood floors dry from the rain. It's important to take protective measures to keep the rain out and off of your beautiful hard wood floors. Water can ruin the finish and stain the floor. Close windows of rain is expected.

Tip 9 – Using plant trays to prevent water damage.
