Six-term Congressman Shares 'Capitol Insight' at Leadership Breakfast

Westmoreland knows what it is to sign the front of a paycheck: He's an entrepreneur who ran his own building company, L.A.W. Builders, while serving 12 years in the Georgia House of Representatives. His hard work and dedication as a champion of lower taxes and smaller government is credited as one of the major reasons the Republican Party was able to win the majority in the Georgia State House for the first time.

He won election to the U.S. House of Representatives in 2004, serving six terms as the U.S. representative for Georgia's Eighth Congressional District, which became the Third District (after a redistricting battle) stretching from the southern suburbs of metro Atlanta into Middle Georgia and to Columbus.

He retired from the 114th Congress (2015-2016) after serving on the House Financial Services Committee, the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence, the House Select Committee on Benghazi, and the Steering Committee, which selects members and leadership for each of the House committees at the start of each Congress or when seats on the committees become available.
