They help to balance out the sweetness and other components. You can use a dash, a

couple of drops or a whole dropper full at a time – there are no rules, and you are the master of your own palate!"

The herbs and spices have been gathered from pristine environments across the state of Michigan, and no artificial dyes or flavors are used to produce Black Ink Bitters. All orders will be sold and shipped in special hand crafted boxes that are designed to add a touch of elegance to the bar, kitchen or wherever they are displayed.
