


History Publishing Company to Publish Atomic Cannons and Nuclear Weapons

Sharp explores the dynamics of the Korean Conflict as it relates to nuclear war in his forthcoming book Atomic Cannons and Nuclear Weapons to assess the possible or definitive use of the atomic cannon against the North Korean invaders.



"The definite use of the atomic cannon in the Korean War was largely as a psychological weapon," says the author. "The enemy knew the United States had it and had used it against another enemy in World War II. Since the North Koreans did not have a nuclear weapon, that was definitely something to think about."
