Based on the product type, implantable ports can be classified into two types: single-lumen and double-lumen ports. During the forecast period, the single-lumen implantable ports segment will continue to grow significantly as these ports are used in the majority of insertion procedures, whereas the double-



lumen implantable ports segment is expected to grow at a high rate.
