The Foundation, in collaboration with art experts, therapists and other professionals of the field, plan to create an artwork collection of the most highly regarded works submitted for the competition that, along with the high artistic value, are also able to support patients emotionally and motivate them in their struggle with the disease.

The artworks submitted for the competition will be exhibited at the oncology patient recovery facilities and published at the Foundation website. Every year, three best works will be awarded with the main awards of 4000 EUR, 2000 EUR and 1000 EUR. Incentive bonuses and special recognition awards may also be granted every month.

The competition jury includes Mr. Einars Repše, Head of Aina Muceniece Virotherapy Foundation, Mr. Aleksejs Naumovs, Professor and painter, rector of the Art Academy of Latvia, Mr. Ojārs Spārītis, Professor, President of the Latvian Academy of Sciences, Mrs. Māra Lāce, Director of the Latvian National Museum of Art; Mr. Kristaps Zariņš, Professor and painter, Pro-rector of the Art Academy of Latvia; Mr. Gļebs Panteļejevs, Professor of the Art Academy of Latvia, sculptor, and Mrs. Sanita Ciganovska, art therapist.
