## Key Highlights

Projects at the execution stage have a total value of US\$64.6 billion, followed by projects at the pre-execution stage with US\$40.0 billion.

Projects in the planning stage amount to US\$20.9 billion while those at the pre-planning stage (announced and study phases) have a combined value of US\$5.4 billion.

Turkey leads airports project investment with US\$37.9 billion, followed by the UK with US\$31.9 billion and Russia with US\$26.2 billion.
