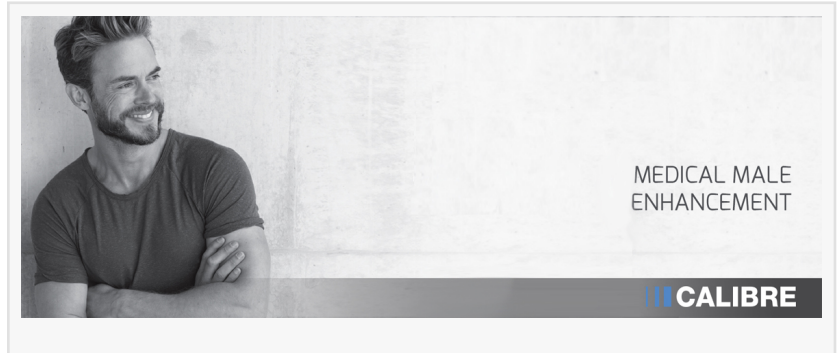


CALIBRE Clinic Research Featured in Aesthetic Surgery Journal

Dr Jayson Oates' research and clinical practice at CALIBRE clinic is featured in the latest edition of Aesthetic Surgery Journal

SYDNEY, NSW, AUSTRALIA, May 24, 2017 /EINPresswire.com/ -- CALIBRE Clinic offers non-surgical penile enlargement procedures, providing men who are concerned with their penis size or appearance an accessible injectable treatment with minimal risks, down time or other negative side effects, compared to existing surgical options. The CALIBRE Clinic penile augmentation procedure was developed by Dr Jayson Oates FRACS, and was recently featured in the Aesthetic Surgery Journal (ASJ)



There are a number of reasons why men may seek out penile augmentation and the numbers of men who are seeking treatment due to dissatisfaction with the size and/ or shape of their penis is increasing. Penile augmentation procedures remain controversial however – there are no standardized recommendations in the literature and limited data regarding outcomes. As more men are searching for treatments, more are being performed and many in private settings. Dr Oates recognised a need for safe and effective minimally invasive treatments to be developed and evaluated, as well as being reported in the medical research literature. In the article for Aesthetic Surgery Journal, Dr Oates focuses on girth enhancement procedures, as the girth of the penis seems to be of particular importance for sexual satisfaction. The article discusses the advantages and disadvantages of the current most commonly used techniques, focusing on minimally invasive injectable techniques to increase penile girth. The article makes recommendations for patient screening, technique selection and perioperative care based on extensive clinical and operative experience.

ASJ is a peer-reviewed international journal, with a focus on scientific developments and the latest clinical techniques in the world of aesthetic surgery. ASJ is the official publication of the American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (ASAPS). The publication of Dr Oates’ research in such a highly regarded journal pays testament to the quality of his work.

A cosmetic medical procedure, CALIBRE involves the painless injection of dermal fillers. The procedure was developed following the use of dermal fillers to augment other areas of the body, notably the face and lips, over the past couple decades. CALIBRE leads to a noticeable increase in

penile girth when the penis is both flaccid and erect, and the effects of the treatment are noticeable immediately. For many patients, a 15ML treatment can lead to an increase in girth of about 1 inch when flaccid or 0.5 to 0.7 inches when erect. Additionally, using larger volumes of filler may lead to an increase in the flaccid penile length due to the weight of the filler. CALIBRE treatment may be applied to both the shaft and head, or glans, of the penis. CALIBRE won't have any negative impacts on erection strength, or sensitivity during sexual activity. Because the treatment is non surgical, it provides a much more convenient option for penis enlargement for many men. It's literally possible to drive away from your appointment and continue with your day as normal. The treatment is long lasting – up to 2 years or longer, depending upon the individual and product used. Small top-ups every year or so will ensure that the size benefits are maintained and repeat injections tend to last longer.

CALIBRE Clinic currently has locations in Perth and Sydney, with plans to expand throughout Asia, Europe, the United States and beyond via training, certification and medical support for an affiliated network of partner Doctors and clinics. The aim is to make CALIBRE an accessible and affordable option for all men interested in Phalloplasty procedures.
