EMNES presents the results of its first Annual Conference in a new website developed by Apogee Information Systems

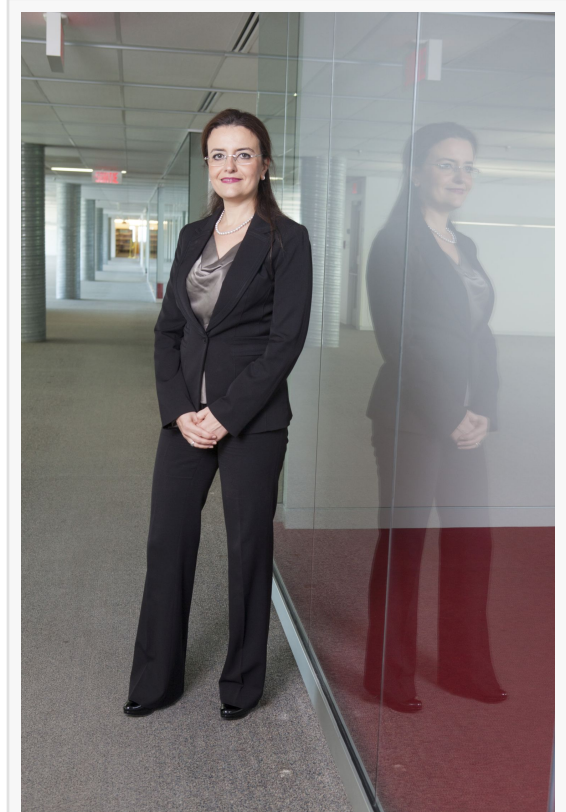
