ManyBabies NYC educates families on disability laws and teaches parents how to advocate for their children’s education empowered with confidence and purpose. The goal is for parents to engage in their child’s learning and social development for their entire academic career.

Ultimately, says Schaneick, parents must embrace the challenges of raising children with special needs,

“Tenacity: if you don’t have it, I encourage you to get it. I can’t do it for you. As a parent, you’re going to have to make some very difficult decisions, and your decisions may not be popular,” says

Schaneick, “but as long as you’re doing what’s in the best interest of your child, you’re making the right decision.”

ManyBabies NYC created by parents for parents. Schaneick has gone above and beyond to help families in all five boroughs.

“When you as a parent receive the services your children need, it means the world,” says Schaneick. “I’m grateful for the opportunity be of service to others because I have a love and passion to see these children be the best individuals they can be.”
