Typically, these high-risk workers were exposed to asbestos in the 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, or 1980's.

The states indicated with the highest incidence of mesothelioma include Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Ohio, West Virginia, Virginia, Michigan, Illinois,



Minnesota, Louisiana, Washington, and Oregon. Mesothelioma also happens in Arizona.
