

## "First People, New Voices" comes to the Grand Performances stage.

Scintillating series kicks off on Saturday, July 1, 2017.

This event will feature artists including hip hop artist Frank Waln (Sicangu Lakota), spoken word poet Tanaya Winder (Southern Ute/Duckwater Shoshone/Pyramid Lake Paiute), and world-renowned dancers The Sampson Brothers (Mvskoke Creek/Seneca). The performance will include a collaborative performance with the contemporary poet Mare Advertencia Lirika (Zapotec) from Oaxaca, Mexico and LA-based MC RedCloud. There will be interactive, educational programs with children and community members the week prior to the performance.

This two-week series will feature artists from North American indigenous communities such as the Zapotecas and the Chumash, bringing not only a rare cultural experience but also showcasing various sounds and movements in accordance to the different tribes. Displaying their community traditions, these artists will bring their rapid poetry and profound lyrics to life this July.
