Because the follicles in the lower back of the scalp are not commonly affected by male pattern baldness, this is the donor site most commonly used. It is important to understand that hair loss is progressive. However, it must be known that a hair transplant procedure does not prevent further loss from non-transplanted areas. If an individual is actively losing hair, he/she may expect that pattern of hair loss to continue.

Hair transplants are at best a semi-permanent and ultimately ineffective solution to a long-term cosmetic problem. With a hair transplant, you are fighting a battle that you will not win against male pattern baldness in the long term. Patients can spend up to \$100,000 for multiple hair transplants and have nothing to show except extensive scarring, in some cases, over their entire scalp.

But now, many of these patients are now turning to a unique hair restoration method.

same application method is used as a camouflage of thinning areas of the scalp. This System received patent status in July of 2015.

This natural look is accomplished by specific varying placement of [replicated follicular hair units](#) with several shades of color, creating an illusion of 3D hair growth. These exclusive shades of pigments are applied in a patented application technique to mimic the natural light and darker areas of naturally buzzed hair. The Weston System<sup>SM</sup> scalp micropigmentation method transitions what essentially is two dimensional into what the human eye depicts as three-dimensional.

Weston's unique system is the first and only in the world of its kind developed as a one-time, one-appointment only permanent application.
