Since the organization started working in 1969, the number, and rate, of women dying from complications of pregnancy and childbirth has been halved (UNPFA).

Recent studies have shown that there is a link between exposure to <u>air pollution</u> and premature birth, birth defects, low birth weight, and <u>infertility</u>. "Ambient Air Pollution and Preterm Birth in the Environment and Pregnancy Outcomes Study at the University of California, Los Angeles" found that ultrafine particles can be especially dangerous for pregnant women. The experimental data demonstrated that the toxins can cross the placenta and reach fetal organs.
