United Nations. Elaborate artistic street play, symbolizing the 11,000 protests across Iran, which

speaks to the Iranian people's desire for regime change, will be performed.

Over the past year, the Iranian people have held over 11,000 protest acts nationwide. More than 3,100 people have been executed in Iran during Rouhani's tenure. Tehran's nefarious regional conduct and ballistic missile tests are continuing unabated. The UN Secretary General has

highlighted the 1988 massacre of 30,000 political prisoners in Iran as new evidence implicates

regime's leaders, including Rouhani's cabinet ministers, as key players in the massacre that has never been independently investigated.
