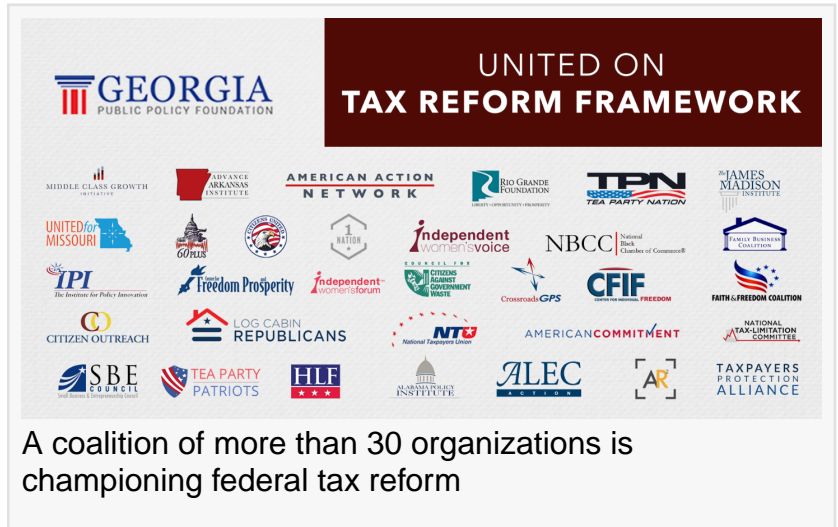


# Georgia Public Policy Foundation Joins Coalition Applauding Federal Tax Reform Framework

It’s past time to give tax relief to American middle-class wage earners and allow job creators to compete.”

“Supporting federal tax reform is a no-brainer for the Georgia Public Policy Foundation,” said Kelly McCutchen, president of the Atlanta-based nonprofit public policy research group that has long campaigned for lower tax rates and a broader tax base in Georgia.

“With Georgia’s income tax linked to the federal code, the federal changes should result in new revenue and allow Georgia lawmakers to follow suit and lower our state income tax rate. The result should be that Georgia’s workers will keep even more of their hard-earned dollars.”
