He grew up in a household of entertainers as the son of an African American and Barbadian or "Basian" from Barbados father, Cuba Gooding, Sr., and an African American and Irish mother who were both singers and entertainers. "My dad was the lead singer of the R&B group, "The Main Ingredient," and traveled the world," said Gooding. "My brother Cuba, Jr. is an Oscar-winner."

Gooding's career took off when he landed a series regular role for three years on a Nickelodeon TV show, "Wild and Crazy Kids," followed by a five-year run on the ABC network series, "Hanging with Mr. Cooper," and then a three-year run on the WB network series, "Smart Guy." After years on television, it was a natural progression for Gooding to act in the movies.
