installment. But there is more demand for the local credit card rather than an international card. So it would be great opportunities for major international players to enter the market.

In order to increase credit card usage, the National Commission for Democracy has taken several measures in the form of fees and interest rates to reduce credit card transactions. Most recently, in January 2017, the crawling lines offered by credit card issuers were banned.

In the new regulation, when a credit card holder enters a revolving credit pattern and cannot repay the loan within the first 30 days, the bank should provide a credit option to pay the remaining outstanding interest rates. The card issuers had given the term of April 3, 2017, to comply with the rules.

The establishment of digital banks, there is a possibility of a speed increase towards electronic payments in Brazil. Fintech Company Control Brazil started its mobile-sole bank Neon in July 2016. Identifying faces to gain access to their account and additional transactions including transfer and payment.

When customers sign up, biometric authentication with their own photos must be enrolled in their mobile phone, which will be used for future certification.

Earlier, in September 2014, the first mobile bank service was launched across the country which enabled customers to conduct banking transactions through their mobile phones. Visa launched by the visa checkout service in Brazil in October 2015. Visa Checkout is a payment solution that stores users 'payment and shipping details, provides quick checkout on partner partners' websites or apps. Similarly, MasterCard launched its master pass payment solution in Brazil in July 2015.

Alternative payment solutions cover in the report are PayPal, Masterpass, Visa Checkout, Samsung Pay, Boleto Bancário, Oi Paggo, MercadoPago, and Stelo.

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
