Through it all, Rhau had gotten support from his friend Bishop Habel Cesar Novas, a United States Army Veteran of Dominican background. Although not a direct victim of the unfortunate event which occurred in Haiti, Rhau had his fair share of some of the worst experiences living in a place of nothingness.

The story, although it accounts personal experiences, it teaches a lesson in life about the different struggles that every individual encounters. Furthermore, it gives interesting facts about what really transpired during the earthquake and how Haiti survived after it. Rhau shares how strong his faith was and how stronger it continually gets, to make people ponder that there's not a challenge that they cannot surpass.
