

Shema Kolainu Free Autism Workshop a Success

Ms. Fuchs supported her talk with numerous examples taken from Skinner’s work and her personal experience as an ABA Therapist and a student, pursuing Post-Master’s Degree in Board Certified Behavior Analyst Program (BCBA).

The workshop achieved its primary goal of providing parents, caregivers and professionals with practical guidelines of teaching autistic children language and other vital skills essential for their future.
