What to Consider Before Creating a Wet Room

Drainage is the key to a successful wet room and a professional should be hired or consulted to ensure optimum waterproofing before installing a wet room kit. The entire floor may need to be raised a little, if the house is older to ensure the water flows in the right direction. Wet room kits make drainage easy, as they utilise a huge tray that can be installed and tiled over while catching the water flow. This eliminates the need for the entire floor to be primed for catching water. Regardless of the choice, the room does still need to be waterproofed and covered in a substance to ensure water doesn't leak into beams or concrete. It's also a good idea to raise the door ledge by five centimetres or more, should a blockage occur and water should rise. This prevents the water from escaping the room.

How to Keep Items Dry in a Wet Room

There are some items that are best kept dry in a wet room such as toilet roll and towels. This can easily be achieved with the use of a screen which also removes the need for a partition wall. The screen is readily available at <u>City Plumbing Supplies</u> as part of a wet room kit or as an extra.

Tiles to Choose When Creating a Wet Room

Although marble looks great in a wet room, it will need treating every few months to stop the absorption of water. Marble is porous and porous tiles will create extra maintenance. Ceramic is usually the best option as these repel water naturally. Good tile shops will also have differing options for floor tiles, to ensure there's little danger of slipping.

Heating in a Wet Room

Good ventilation is essential in a wet room as is heating. Many choose underfloor heating to dry out the wet room and any standing water quickly. A <u>heated towel rail</u> is also a popular choice as it adds an extra layer of luxury to the room.
