Robotic Surgical Platform Provides Personalized Surgical Procedure

Appleton, WI: The Orthopedic & Sports Institute of the Fox Valley is the first <u>orthopedic center</u> in Northeastern Wisconsin to utilize the Mako Robotic-Arm Assisted Surgery. This latest advancement in <u>robotic technology</u> changes the way these surgeries are performed.

Using CT scans and the Mako technology, surgeons create individualized 3-D reconstruction plans for each patient. After intensive planning, the robotic arm assists the surgeon, who performs the surgery, in replacing joints and balancing ligaments within the affected area, providing higher level of customization for implant alignment and positioning. The high accuracy of the computer navigation also decreases the risk of soft tissue damage during the procedure.

Mako technology has been in use since June 2006, when it was used in a partial knee replacement. It has since been utilized in over 83,000 knee and hip replacements, earning a respected reputation. It assists in both partial and total knee replacements and total hip replacements, bringing relief to those suffering from arthritis and moderate deformities.

OSI performs Mako Robotic-Arm Assisted Surgeries at the main campus in Appleton. Post-surgery, patients can recover in OSI's elite Recovery Inn. A facility like no other, with the feel of a top-rated hotel, Recovery Inn provides personalized care, including physical and occupational therapy, as its highly trained staff works with patients towards complete healing.

Consultation appointments are available to discuss if Mako Robotic-Arm Assisted Surgery is the best option for patients. It is covered by many health insurance providers.
