

IT Governance encourages compliance professionals to participate in its second GDPR survey and win £350 voucher

However, we do expect to find a few companies who have not begun their project yet, which considering the law will come into force on 25 May 2018 and imposes extortionate fines for companies that are in breach with the Regulation, is concerning."

The 2017 GDPR Report emphasised the lack of skills and resources required to help organisations achieve GDPR compliance as one of the main challenges faced by organisations. Furthermore, results suggested that professionals were struggling with conducting risk assessments, creating policies and procedures, and conducting a data protection impact assessment or a data audit in compliance with the Regulation.

IT Governance would like to hear from data protection professionals about what their business is doing, or planning to do, in order to achieve compliance with the GDPR. All the responses to the survey will be treated anonymously and participants can opt in to receive a copy of the report.

Moreover, participants in the GDPR Survey have the chance to win a £350 IT Governance voucher, which can be used on their own professional development or to help support GDPR compliance projects.
