- Overall telecom service revenue in Kenya will grow at a CAGR of 6.1% during 2017-2022.
- Mobile revenue will account for 94.7% of total telecom revenue in 2022, driven by increasing adoption of mobile broadband and 4G services.
- 3G will be the most adopted mobile technology in 2022. Rising demand for high-speed data service and expansion of the 3G network will drive subscriber growth.
- Safaricom holds a majority 74.0% share of total mobile subscriptions led by expansion of the 4G/LTE network and 4G+/LTE-A network via carrier aggregation. We expect the competition to intensify further as all operators are focusing on LTE expansion with a focus on mobile data services.
- Operators will also focus on expanding fiber deployments and cater to the rising data demand.
