

## IT Governance encourages professionals involved in compliance to participate in its 2018 GDPR Survey & win \$500 voucher

However, we do expect to find a few companies who have not begun their project yet, which considering the law will come into force on 25 May 2018 and imposes extortionate fines for companies that are in breach with the Regulation, is concerning."

Many organizations in the United States will be required to comply with a mixture of state, federal, industry-specific, and international cybersecurity regulations. There are significant challenges to overcome when trying to achieve compliance with multiple laws, regulations, and standards, and thus different organizations can adopt a variety of compliance strategies, which may lead to gaps and mistakes.

The 2017 GDPR Report emphasized the lack of skills and resources required to help organizations achieve GDPR compliance as one of the main challenges faced by organizations. Furthermore, results suggested that professionals were struggling with conducting risk assessments, creating policies and procedures, and conducting a data protection impact assessment or a data audit in compliance with the Regulation.

IT Governance would like to hear from data protection professionals about what their business is

doing, or planning to do, in order to achieve compliance with the GDPR. All the responses to the survey will be treated anonymously and participants can opt in to receive a copy of the report.
