"The best treatment alternative for prominent veins on the hands is their permanent removal, rather than the use of injectable fillers or fat transfers which must often be repeated and could result in an unnatural-looking (puffy) hands," says Dr. Goren.

To address these concerns Dr. Goren adopted and revised the minimally invasive European technique known as "Ambulatory Phlebectomy" (or AP) used for bulging leg's varicosities, approach he uses since 1989.

Two years later his article (co-written with Prof. Albert Yellin, Head Dept. of Vascular Surgery, USC Med. School) was the first write-up on the subject in the American Surgical literature. The article, introducing the method to the American Surgical establishment, was published in the Am. Journal of Surgery, 1991; vol. 162; pages 166-74.

The Rejuvahand™ technique treats both hands in about two to three hours with no downtime. The unwanted veins are removed in small sections through tiny (1-3mm) entry points that heal with no stitches or scars. Dr. Goren has performed close to 500 cases with complete success and permanent results; one single recurrence was observed in a professional weightlifter patient.
