

# Bible Gateway News Ranks Scourby You Bible App No. 1 for 2018

text and audio, but users had to manually scroll the text to keep up with the audio. This new "Bible-Gateway" was the beginning of the "reading and hearing" of the Word of God by the masses.

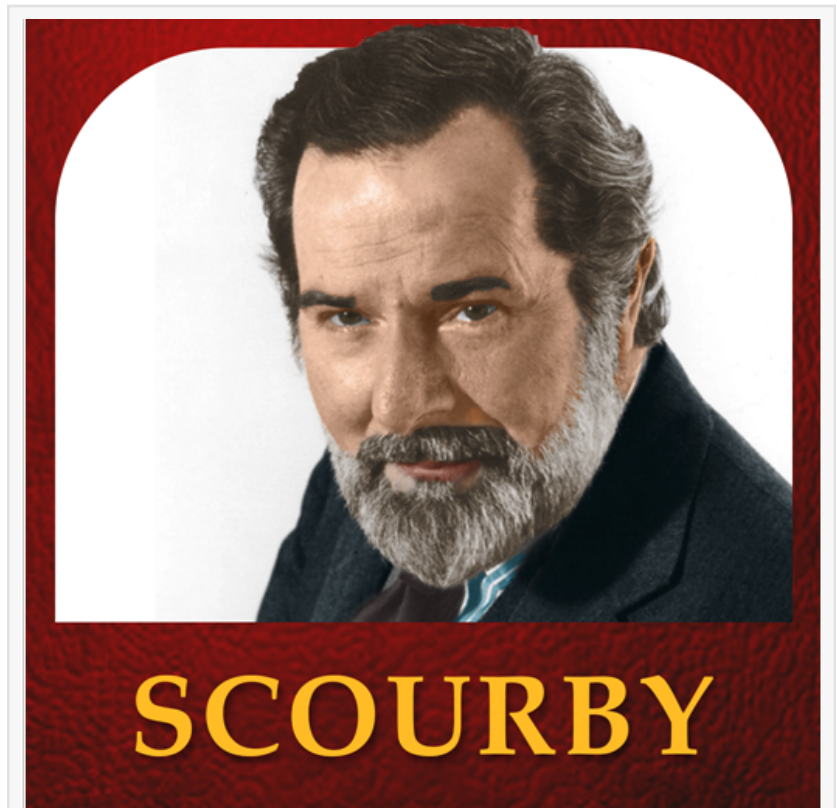
and one for hearing, studies have shown that comprehension, understanding and retention are all dramatically increase..."Blessed is he that readeth and they that hear the words of this Prophecy, and keep the things which are written therein, for the time is at hand"...(Revelations 3:1) The important three words in the above verse are "reading, hearing and keeping". Today, there are tens of millions of Christians who are now hearing and reading the Word using a Bible App. There is no doubt, for most Christians in 2018, a Bible app on their smart phone is a must, and they won't leave home without one.

Bible Gateway's News observation was that the Pope's message was profound. The Pope recognized that everyone carries cell-phones and what if they used the Bible as much as they used their cellphones. Millions have Bible Apps on their cellphones and Bible Gate News wanted to know what Bible App is the Best in 2018? According to Bible Gateway News, they decided to research that question. Having a very extensive Christian Data Base, they identified 1000 random Bible App users around the country. They polled them and asked the following questions:

1. What do you think are the most important components in a Bible App are? Top Answers, the quality of the narration, quality of the Bible App Features, text and audio being synced together, and the audio self contained on the device and not streamed from the cloud.

2. Question: What Bible Version is your their favorite? Answer: The King James Version came in first at 57%, NIV came in at 18% and the other 100 plus English Bible versions were split among between the other 25%.
