Physically I improved, but emotionally I struggled to come to terms with the idea I was going to survive HIV. I'd gotten so used to the idea of dying, to the point it was a comfort to me. I'd absolved myself from the responsibility of life. Everything I thought I knew was turned upside down. HIV is no longer a death sentence for the majority. My problem wasn't dying anymore, it was living. It's the same for millions of others with HIV the world over. I had to find a way to co-exist with the virus and the result of my journey was the First Edition of HIV HAPPY, self-published in 2015.
