There are several tools that can be implemented to improve the role of the CPS [according to Brett H. Pritchard](#). He believes family and individual counseling is a good starting point and that this should happen while the children remain in the home if possible. If it does become necessary to remove a child from the family home, they should be placed in the care of other family members whenever it's a viable option. Foster care should only be considered as a last resort.
