That for the individual patient, success is defined by maximum improvement and customization. The successful nose job is proportional to the face, shows no telltale signs of surgery and in a word, looks "natural."

Prospective patients of Dr. Kotler are welcome to bring photos of a celebrity or a friend's nose as an example of what they like about a particular nose. Kotler holds that "the rhinoplasty specialist needs to

be a good listener to best understand the patient's desires." That "both the patient and the surgeon must agree on what is appropriate and achievable for that particular patient."

"To bring forth a meeting of the minds at consultation," Kotler continues, "computer imaging is unmatched as a communication vehicle. As the 'before' morphs into the 'after', there emerges the blueprint for a likely successful procedure."
