It is also important to have a plan in place for when severe weather is forecasted. The driver will want to think about how to protect their vehicle whether they are at work or at home. Anyone with a garage should use it when inclement weather is predicted. It is also a good idea to stop driving and pull over to lessen the damage to a vehicle. Driving at higher speeds will increase the likelihood of damage in a storm. For people who do not have any type of protected building for their vehicles, they can purchase covers which can reduce damage or even prevent it. These covers can be put in place even if the car is in a parking lot. It is also a good idea to park beside a building in the opposite direction of the storm.

If a storm does occur and the vehicle is out in it, the owner should check for damage right away. However, that does not always mean they will be able to spot dents made by hail. It is a good idea to take the vehicle to a trusted body shop to have it inspected. Once the person knows the cost of the damage, they can decide whether to handle it out of pocket or through an insurance claim. If the cost of the damage is less than the deductible, it makes sense not to turn in a claim. Summer storms can be severe, but drivers can be prepared with the right coverage for car insurance in Colorado Springs.
