Europe dominates with major share in the Healthcare Transportation Services Market

Europe was the largest market for emergency in 2017. The European region gained a revenue of \$26.68 billion in 2017. The market is further expected to maintain its dominance, and to grow at a CAGR of 1.04% to reach a revenue of \$28.38 billion by 2023. Among all the regions, the fastest growing region is Asia-Pacific. The Asia-Pacific market is projected to grow at a CAGR of 10.1% to reach a revenue of \$21.96 billion by 2023. Growing aging population, and increasing chronic diseases is driving the demand for emergency medical transportation. APAC regions have started its investments since 2017, and thus been growing significantly during the forecast period.

In global healthcare transportation services, the market is segmented into medical transportation and non-medical transportation. The major share was gained by medical transportation in 2017, accounting to \$78.31 billion in 2017. The market for medical transportation will grow at a CAGR of 3.93%, and to reach a size of \$98.27 billion by 2023. Non-medical transportation is predicted to be the fastest growing market at 10.2% of CAGR, and to rise in courier transportation services for medical applications, rises. In medical transportation services, one of the segments is patient transportation, which accounted for \$72.65 billion in 2015, and is set to rise to the size of \$90.61 billion by 2023.
