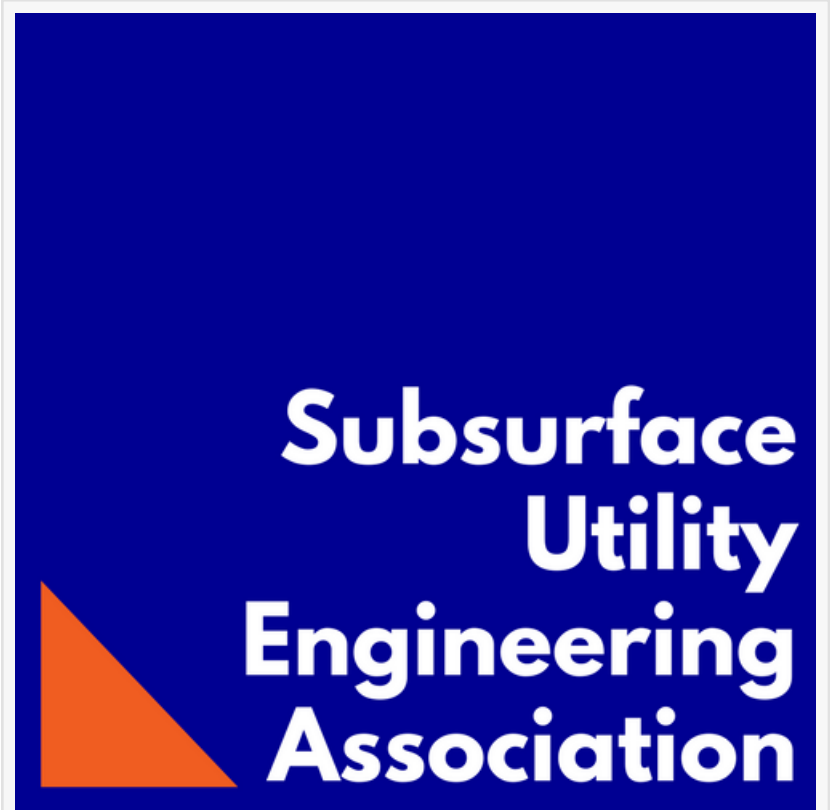


Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Association to Form
