That's why Dean rallied up the money and was able to donate \$5K to the Shriners Club. He is happy to support an organization that is so constant and steadfast across the globe.


About the Shriners Club

Yet, the Shriners Club is not associated with one religion. It only commands that their followers have a belief higher than themselves.




Charities throughout the world are helped by the Shriners Club. However, their main philanthropic act revolves around the Shriners Hospitals for Children.
