


New Online Class in SQL Reporting Exceeds Expectations

The hands-on class, offered by <u>Microsoft Partner Signzilla</u> <u>Training</u>, incorporated use of a virtual machine connection. Each student can individually and independently log in and work through exercises with provided software, immediately

after learning a concept from the live instructor. Students were able to connect to a database and manipulate data into various reports. The entire class is conducted online, convenient for busy

professionals who cannot take much time off from work to attend training.

14 students took advantage of this firsttime offering of the class, hailing from California to Maryland, and Texas to Minnesota. International students from Canada and India participated as well. Due to the success of this new course, a second class will be offered again on July 20. It is anticipated that <u>future</u> <u>classes will be offered</u> beyond that date.
