The Duritium® III+PA plates are rated Level III with the National Institute of Justice (NIJ), which means they will withstand impact from high-powered rifles, like the AR-15 used in many school shootings in recent years. And, with a weight of around three pounds and about half an inch thick, they are also far less bulky than the previous ceramic plates worn by the Officers.

"They put it on the line each and every day to secure our staff and our students," said Superintendent Tom Bratton. "It's a wonderful opportunity to make them safer."

Some of the employees at ShotStop have children in the Stow-Munroe Falls school system, and because the company is based in Stow it was happy to help.
