In 2013, Shape Magazine recognized Westphal's battle with cancer, enduring three months of IV chemotherapy and nearly a dozen surgeries related to her battle with cancer and knee problems suffered from her 70-pound weight loss.

"I am an aging woman who feels 'called' to better serve as much and in as many capacities as possible. My charter is to be a beacon of hope, inspiration and to share an example of possibility, improvement, empowerment and growth at any age."

Westphal will compete in three categories during the Mrs. Virginia America pageant: personal interview, swimsuit, and evening gown. Contestants must be married and live in the city or county they

represent. The winner will receive a prize package worth thousands of dollars and she will compete for the title of Mrs. America in August 2019 in Las Vegas, Nevada.
