Juvéderm is the ideal treatment for wrinkles and lines that are present when your face is at rest, whereas Botox is generally used for wrinkles that appear when muscles move and contract. Juvéderm is also better when it comes to filling in hollows and giving the appearance of volume, which is why it's better suited to static wrinkles. So for those deep lines that appear on your forehead or around your eyes when you're not smiling, nasolabial folds and frown lines, Juvéderm is the answer.

How is Juvederm applied?

Like Botox, Juvéderm is applied using an injection. Skills practitioners such as Dr. Muhammad Mirza carefully measure out the dose and apply them to affected areas. Treatments generally take between 15 minutes and an hour, and the downtime is extremely minimal, meaning you can visit the clinic and return to your normal daily activity soon after leaving.

The results are generally immediate and, although it varies from person to person, will last for about a year once applied. For maintaining the optimal smooth look it may be necessary to get minor touch-ups, but this should be discussed with your doctor or skin care expert first.
