The Fort Harrison was once used to accommodate the World War II troupes and the Philadelphia Phillies for spring training. Other notable guests who've stayed at the Fort Harrison include the Rolling Stones who had an appearance at the Jack Russell stadium in 1965 which was cut short due to "hundreds of teen-agers who tried to get to the 'rock men.'" It was at this time and place where Mick Jagger and Keith Richards penned the chart topping song, (I Can't Get No) Satisfaction.

After the tour, those who want to know more about the Church's Spiritual Cathedral across the street – the Flag Building can visit the Scientology Information Center and watch "Inside Scientology: Flag," an episode from the Scientology TV Network. The 1 hour presentation provides a visual tour of the building and an intimate look at the history and significance of the Church of Scientology's spiritual headquarters.
