When the safety flooring isn't designed correctly, it can cause bruising and injuries due to the brittle nature of children's bones.

A safer flooring option

Ezymats identifies a few critical differences in their EVA foam compared to other safety flooring options. EVA as a material is naturally very soft and durable, offering ample protection for anyone that falls onto it. It provides a cushioned fall, which helps prevent the impact on joints and bones in young children. As a result, there will be less chance of injuries occurring during playtime.

The mats themselves come in three different thicknesses; 20mm, 30mm or 40mm. The thicker the mat, the more protection and cushioning it can deliver. Ezymats suggests that a thicker mat is chosen dependent on how vigorous the activity is. For home play areas, a lighter thickness may be all that's required. However, for professional indoor play areas where a variety of high-impact activities take place, then a thicker option is more effective. Each mat comes in 1m x 1m and can be interlocked with other EVA foam tiles like a jigsaw puzzle. Another unique feature of this safety flooring is that it can very easily be cut with a knife. This means the tiles can be cut and fitted around awkward areas such as furniture or play equipment. They also come in different colours - blue/red, black/grey, and black/red - with custom colour schemes also available.

The future for Ezymats

As a company that focuses on safety, Ezymats is determined to offer the best solutions to minimise injuries for small children. EVA foam is most certainly a giant step in the right direction to reduce the number of severe injuries in child's play areas - both commercially and inside the home. The properties of this particular material make it comfortable for kids to play on, but also

a lot safer too. As such, parents and children's play area owners can feel more at ease that there will be fewer accidents during playtime.
