


Diabetes Is The Leading Reason For Podiatric Services, A New Report From The Business Research Company Shows

Regions where diabetes is more prevalent, such as the Middle East and Africa, have slightly above the average proportion of podiatric treatment related to diabetes, but the disease accounts for over 37% of all podiatry service expenditure in every region.

assessment and treatment of diabetic foot ulcers, as well as foot care to prevent amputations of the lower limbs in the diabetic population. It also includes the diagnosis and treatment for foot infections and care of wounds caused by diabetes.

The other major diseases related to podiatric treatment are musculoskeletal, cardiovascular and neurological diseases. Only 15% of the global podiatric treatment market is related to non-co-morbid conditions. Musculoskeletal diseases-related podiatry includes the assessment and treatment of foot problems such as arthritis (osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis), which lead to acute or chronic pain in the lower limbs, and other related conditions of the lower limb. This segment does not include the joint replacement surgery of foot and ankle that are performed in severe cases of arthritis. Cardiovascular diseases-related podiatry includes the assessment and treatment of problems such as peripheral vascular disease which results from poor circulation of blood to the feet due to cardiovascular conditions. This segment also includes infections arising due to poor blood circulation to the feet. Neurological diseases-related podiatry includes the assessment and treatment of peripheral neuropathy which leads to numbness or weakness in the lower limbs due to an insufficient supply of nutrients to the nerves. Non-co-morbid conditions related podiatry include the assessment and treatment of non-comorbid conditions such as fungal nail infections and associated complications, and also includes footwear advice for people with foot disorders.
