Once complete, the Sharefest Youth Leadership Center will provide a safe space for learning, offer healing with trauma-informed mental health services, and help students develop college and career pathways. "Students will be assigned to small cohorts who will journey together from middle school to high school to college and beyond. It's a really unique approach that gives students consistent support and accountability during the years they need it most, " says Salvador Sanchez, Jr. Program Director for the Youth Leadership Center.

Sharefest's goal for every student who leaves the with the Youth Leadership Center is for them to have a clear plan and purpose to go on to lead lives of success and lead change in their community.
