


Innovative one- stop shop for pregnancy and postpartum mental health

The program offers rapid access to collaborative, specialized care in an effort to prevent hospitalization and support prevention, identification and treatment of postpartum depression and related illnesses. "The collaborative relationship between psychiatry and mental health counseling at one place allows for communication between providers and the result of better care for the individuals and families we work with," adds DePaola.
