Students of the [Allentown charter school](#) can use the program's online site to submit anonymous tips which are then reviewed by a crisis center. The crisis center can get in contact with school administrators and law enforcement.

"It is important that we create a safe environment for our students," says Robert Lysek, founder and CEO of the [Lehigh Valley charter school](#). "If they see something unusual, they should feel safe to say something."

According to the program, large numbers of students report having been bullied and a majority who plan on harming themselves or others speak out or show some sort of indicators.
